Dear Friends

We are pleased to invite you to the 4^{th} annual DIWWAAAS conference to be held in Chennai on Aug the 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 4^{th} . The theme this year is Diabetes and Pregnancy: Before, During and Beyond. Several brilliant national speakers and two outstanding international experts have agreed to be a part of the program.

Gestational diabetes has emerged as a critical issue not just during pregnancy but as a precursor of diabetes and heart disease in women. It also has trans generational and multi generational impact affecting the future generations in very serious ways. Young women are increasingly at high risk for obesity, prediabetes and diabetes during their reproductive years making the risk of pregestational diabetes and other pregnancy related complications at historically high rates. Preconception care is a major unmet need.

A dedicated workshop on maternal nutrition is planned for Aug 2nd with national nutrition experts leading the discussions and providing hands on training. Day 1 of the conference will cover important areas like PCOS, Pre gestational diabetes, optimization of birth weight, auto immune disorders like thyroid dysfunction and address the current challenges like gestational weight gain, implementing universal screening etc. Day 2 will cover many aspects of providing care for women with GDM and post partum care and long term follow up. Special issues like genetics, role of ultrasound, self monitoring of glucose, technology and artificial intelligence in gestational diabetes will be discussed. Prediction and prevention of type 2 diabetes in women with GDM and the HAPO follow up study are major highlights of the conference. In addition a session titled "Sneak peek" will showcase several clinical scenarios in the form of role play.

This conference is aimed to bring together scientific evidence and clinical practice in a perfect yet simple manner and will be most useful to 0b gyns, physicians, endocrinologists, diabetologists, nutritionists and all involved in women's health in general and maternal health in particular.

The DIWWAAAS team is looking forward to welcoming you to an exciting, comprehensive, practical and much needed scientific program that is designed to help delegates with answers and tools for their patient care.
