Dr Young is Professor of Medicine in the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine and Vice-Chair of the Division of Endocrinology, Diabetes, Metabolism, and Nutrition. He received his MD degree from Michigan State University. Dr Young trained in internal medicine at William Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak, Michigan, and in Endocrinology and Metabolism at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, Minnesota. He is senior editor for Clinical Endocrinology and editor-in-chief of the Mayo Clinic Endocrinology Update Newsletter. He is the recipient of multiple education awards, including the Mayo Fellows Association Teacher of the Year Award in Internal Medicine and the Mayo School of Continuing Medical Education Outstanding Faculty Member Award. Professor Young is interested in the following areas: Endocrine Hypertension, Adrenal Disorders, Pituitary Disorders and Medical Editing.


Prof John Morris is Chair of the department of Endocrinology and Metabolism at the Mayo clinic. After graduating from the University of Tennessee, Nashville Tenn., he did his fellowship and residency at the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine and the University of Tennessee. A diplomat of the American Board of Internal Medicine and Endocrinology, his special interest are Staff and Trainee Education, Hyper- and Hypothyroidism, Graves' disease, Thyroid Cancer, Chronic Wound Healing and Inpatient Endocrinology. He is the Chair of Laboratory Services Committee, American Thyroid Association, 2005-present and a member of the board of directors of the American Thyroid Association, 2001-2005. He and his laboratory are expert in Gene Transfer, Vector Construction, Radioiodine Uptake and Therapy, and Imaging Techniques, especially using the Sodium-iodide Symporter as a reporter.






Prof Sreekumaran Nair graduated from the State University of New York, Albany, NY and obtained his certifications from the Royal College of Physicians, London, England and the American College of Physicians - American Society of Internal Medicine. His areas of interest are Diabetes Mellitus, Lipid Disorders and Skeletal Muscle Metabolism and Aging. He has been the recipient of many awards. He has an Honorary Doctorate in Medicine/Foreign Adjunct Professorship, Karolinska Institute, Stockholm, 2008.

Professor Bart Clarke is a graduate of the University of California, Los Angeles California, and he did his residency and fellowship from the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine. He is Consultant and Chair, Metabolic Bone Disease Core Group, Division of Endocrinology, Metabolism, Diabetes, and Nutrition, Mayo Clinic. A diplomat of the American Board of Internal Medicine and Endocrinology, his areas of special interest are Steroid-induced Osteoporosis, Transplantation Osteoporosis, Alcohol-induced Bone Disease, Primary Hyperparathyroidism, Paget's Disease, Metabolic Bone Disease.





Donald D. Hensrud, M.D., is an Associate Professor of Preventive Medicine and Nutrition at Mayo Clinic College of Medicine and a consultant in the Divisions of Preventive, Occupational, and Aerospace Medicine; and Endocrinology, Diabetes, Metabolism, and Nutrition. He is chair of the Division of Preventive, Occupational, and Aerospace Medicine. Dr. Hensrud received his B.S. from the University of North Dakota, M.D. degree from the University of Hawaii, M.P.H. from the University of Minnesota, and M.S. in nutrition from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He completed residency training in Internal Medicine and fellowship training in Preventive Medicine at Mayo Clinic, and completed a Clinical Nutrition fellowship at the University of Alabama at Birmingham.
